



AFRICA, LATIN AMERICA & ASIA


THE KBF WAS ENGAGED IN 69 COUNTRIES IN 2022

In 2019 two projects (Business Partnership Facility; Common Goal Fund) were launched for a total amount of more than € 3 million. In 2021, KBF's engagement increased significantly in response to the COVID-19 crisis. Several philanthropic funds, either existing or set up at the time, notably by companies, responded massively to solidarity needs on all continents, and in particular in India. With the figures for 2022, the 5-year trend is still clearly upwards, but back to more moderate growth.


