1. PERFORMANCE TRACK RECORD: Goal getter, entrepreneurial and resilient

- Top Performance: Individuals who have demonstrated excellent performances in <u>at least two areas</u>
 - 1. Academic: Excellent grades (Magna C. laude), Additional Master, studied at top Uni abroad
 - 2. **Professional**: Strong on-the-job results in business, governmental, or not-for-profit
 - 3. Extra-curricular: Achievements in sports (fex national team), student leader, scouts leader, ...
 - 4. Entrepreneurial: Launched a company, creative side-project, a new corporate or social initiative
- Accomplishments in Adversity: Individuals who have achieved solid results despite exceptional life circumstances

2. IMPACT OF THE GRANT: Expected impact on the candidate, his/her career, and on Society at large

- PAF Personal Empowerment: If a candidate comes from an underprivileged part of society, and demonstrated drive for breaking any societal 'glass ceiling'. PAF will open doors and a network that otherwise would be hard to access.
- PAF Pivotal Career impact: The grant offers new career opportunities that could not be obtained without PAF
- PAF Cross-roads impact: The candidate clearly motivated why the PAF comes at the right time in his/her career
- Impact through the PAF Project: The candidate has a clear and compelling vision on how he/she wants to use
 the grant to drive the Belgian economy and society forward during the PAF year, and in the years after.

3. SOCIAL ATTITUDE: Interpersonal skills and Societal engagement

- Team Spirit: Candidate illustrates examples of having worked successfully in a team.
- Community involvement: Has demonstrated leadership at scouts, in a sports or student organisation
- Societal engagement: Has volunteered or worked in not-for-profit, engaged in a political party, etc.
- Strong interpersonal skills: Has demonstrated the social intelligence and empathy necessary to build trust and cooperation with colleagues, clients, and other stakeholders.

4. Intercultural awareness and adaptability

- Language skills: Is fluent in several languages
- International exposure: Studying or working abroad, travelling abroad, grown up in a multicultural family
- Cross-cultural Adaptability: Adjusts quickly to new or different cultural settings. Gets up to speed rapidly
- Curiosity: Displays a deep interest in a wide range of topics (business, political, philosophical, societal, ...)
- Cognitive Flexibility: Has embraced new ideas, adapted to change, or shown flexibility in thinking. Remains open
 and receptive under pressure, or after a set-back.

5. EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION: Overall Presence and Ability to Convince

- Communication Clarity: Can convey a message in a compelling, structured, logical and concise way
- Demonstrates integrity and trust
- Presentation & Ability to convince
- Stress-resistance

6. INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS: A strong interest in and affinity for international business

- Motivation PAF project: Demonstrates a strong desire to set up a business development project abroad, and has a sound business logic/reasoning regarding a potential PAF project
- Business Acumen: Demonstrates a good common business sense through direct experience or interest
- International business: Understands importance of differences in consumer behaviour, global regulation, etc.
- Situational awareness: Understands that different approaches work in different places.
