Theme: "Access to water, protection or improvement of water quality and water management in developing countries"

Selection criteria

- 1. <u>Objective</u>. The internship is linked to the access to water or its management in developing countries and must be clearly part of the subject of the candidate's end of year project.
- 2. <u>Pertinence</u>. The work undertaken by the candidate at local level and the results that emanate from this, deal with important local issues.
- 3. <u>Capabilities</u>. The budget requested must match the candidate's needs. He/She must have sufficient resources to complete the internship under the required conditions.
- 4. <u>Originality.</u> The approach chosen by the candidate for his internship or the framework within which he is going to work have an innovative side. They are, in a certain way, different from the usual approaches or frameworks.
- 5. <u>Impact</u>. What will be realized during the internship brings real added value to the scientific approach that supports the end of year thesis.
