

WHAT CAN WE LEARN FROM OUR GRANTEES?

SURVEY OF ORGANISATIONS AND INDIVIDUALS WHO RECEIVED SUPPORT IN 2015-2017

Working together for a better society. At the King Baudouin Foundation, one of the ways we do this is by offering financial support to hundreds of organisations and individuals each year. Independent juries and support committees guarantee independent selections. The Foundation evaluates the projects and individuals it supports to determine their impact. This enables us to fine-tune and adjust our approach and working methods.

But what do grantees themselves think? How have they found implementing their project? And working with the Foundation?

We put these questions to them in an online survey. 56% of grantees responded. Below you'll find the results of this survey together with some additional statistics.

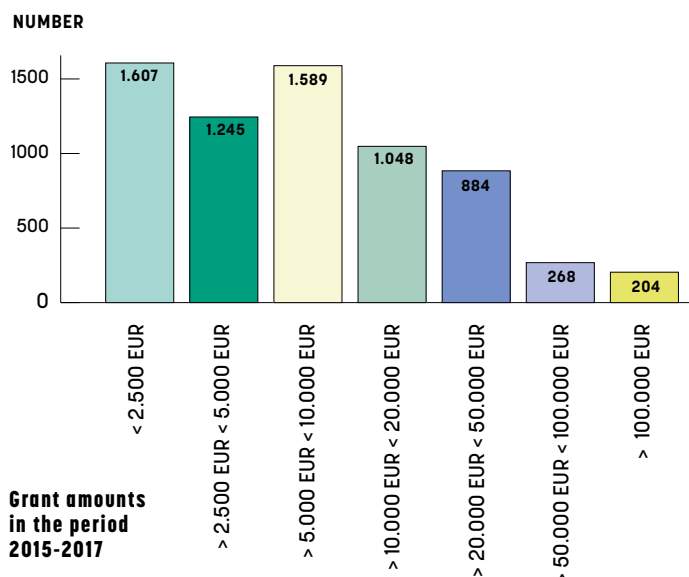
TOTAL AMOUNT AND NUMBER OF GRANTS IN THE PERIOD 2015-2017

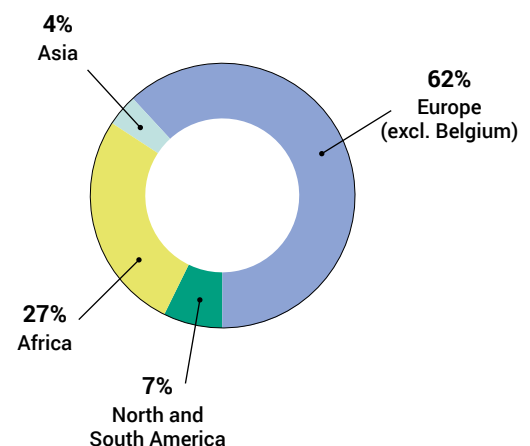

DIVERSE PORTFOLIO: FROM SMALL TO LARGER GRANTS



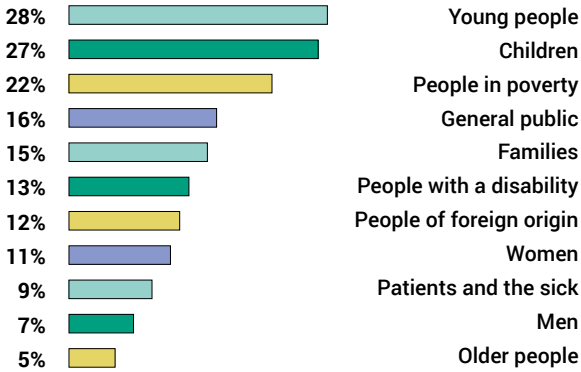
18% OF THE GRANTEES ARE ACTIVE OUTSIDE BELGIUM



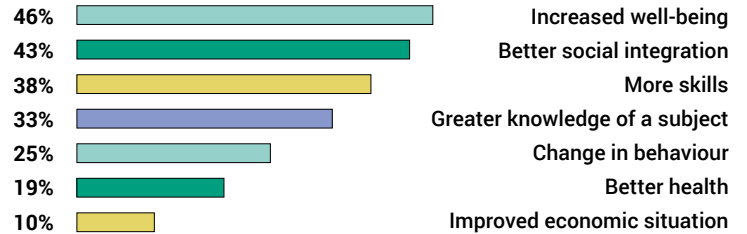
WHO ARE THE TARGET GROUPS OF SUPPORTED ORGANISATIONS AND INDIVIDUALS?

Based on extrapolation, all supported organisations and individuals together reach at least 260,000 people every year.

The main target groups are children, young people, people in poverty and vulnerable groups



What changes are grantees effecting within their target groups?



64%

are initiatives in which a grantee is breaking new ground.

6000€

is the average amount of a grant.

18%

are grantees who mainly operate in Europe and Africa.

17 HOURS

is the average time required for a grant: 6 hours for the application procedure and 11 hours for follow-up (administration, accounting, reporting). For smaller amounts it is less.

93%

of supported organisations and individuals publicise their grant. They see it as a badge of quality. Often, a grant is also a means of securing additional funding.

75%

of initiatives would not have been possible without support from the King Baudouin Foundation.
