Competition rules

The 2022 photo competition is organized by the King Baudouin Foundation.

Organization

These rules cover the terms of the '2022 Photo competition'. The organization of the competition is led by the King Baudouin Foundation, Rue Brederode 21, 1000 Brussels. The rules will not be subject to any postal or telephone communications. The Foundation may, at any moment, modify the rules by mentioning such modification on its website www.kbs-frb.be.

The competition is open to:

- individuals and associations who have received financial support from the King Baudouin Foundation in 2021
- project accounts active in 2021

Competition

- The purpose of the competition is as follows:
 - Send us a maximum of 3 photos that illustrate what you have achieved in 2021 thanks to the support of the King Baudouin Foundation.
- The competition will take place as follows:
 - You can enter a maximum of 3 photos.
 - Photos that have already been entered for the Foundation's previous photo competitions will not be accepted.
 - The jury will select maximum 1 photo per association/individual
 - You can participate by uploading your photos here http://photocontest.images.kbs-frb.be/#en. Photo's which are not uploaded by this link, will not be taken into account for the competition.
 - You can submit your photos from 15/12/2021 until 18/01/2022.
 - An independent jury will select the most graphic photos. Each of these will receive 200 euros.
 - The general public can vote on our Internet website www.kbs-frb.be for one of the photos nominated by the jury to decide which are the 'best' photos. Each of these winning photos will receive an additional 500 euros.
 - The photo that receives the most 'likes' on Facebook and Instagram will be awarded an additional prize (Social Media Favorite) of 500 euros.
 - The winning photos will be published at the end of April 2022.
 - Simply by participating, each participant authorises automatically and unconditionally the publication of his/her name and photo. He/She accepts being identified as an entrant to the competition and relinquishes all rights in this field.
 - The participant gives the authorisation to the King Baudouin Foundation to publish the photo's in its communication.
- Through participating in the competition the association or participating person declares to have all rights relating to the photo. If one or more person appears on the photo, the participant declares being authorized to reproduce their image.
- The organizers have the right to refuse improper photos.
