





# SUPPORT: DISTRIBUTION BY PROGRAMME\*




\* 2021 has exceptionally high levels of European and international support due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

#### **FINANCIAL SUPPORT**

# **OUR ACTIVITIES**



Professor Pierre Vanderhaeghen received the **Generet Prize for Rare Diseases**, worth one million euros, for his research into abnormalities of brain development.




# **CLIMATE, ENVIRONMENT AND BIODIVERSITY**

We contribute to the protection of our natural resources to fight climate change and find sustainable answers to the needs of society.

The 'Fair Energy Transition for All' project, conducted in nine European countries and initiated by the KBF, gives a voice to the most vulnerable European citizens and those most affected by energy policies.





# **HERITAGE AND CULTURE**

We ensure a future for significant elements of Belgian heritage so as to pass them on to future generations and make them accessible to everyone.

An exhibition at the BELvue museum in Brussels entitled 'Raoul Servais. A world between magic and realism' highlights the work of the pioneer of animated film in Belgium, who has donated a large part of his archives to the Foundation.

## INTERNATIONAL

We facilitate international philanthropy and empower actors of change in the countries of the Global South.

The King Baudouin Foundation, KBFUS, KBF CANADA and Give2Asia create the **Myriad** alliance to facilitate and encourage cross-border giving throughout the world.



The **Business Partnership Facility** support programme run by the Belgian Development Cooperation and the KBF is a 'successful model' according to an external evaluation of its activities.



# **SOCIAL JUSTICE AND POVERTY**

We support initiatives that help the most vulnerable. We encourage new approaches to lowering the risks of poverty and strengthening social cohesion.

More than one in five Belgian households are affected by energy poverty. Facing the rise in energy prices, the Platform against Energy Poverty, managed by the KBF, called for **optimisation of the social tariff**.

### **SOCIAL ENGAGEMENT**

We study and map social engagement. We support public interest initiatives led by citizens, associations and foundations.

# **EUROPE**

We support reflection, platforms for debate, new voices in discussions and the development of solutions for key European challenges. In order to increase our impact, we work with over 50 European partner foundations.

The King Baudouin Foundation helps launch Pluralis, a mission-related investment fund aiming to preserve media independence in Europe.

# EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF TALENTS

We contribute to inclusive and effective education and giving every talented person an opportunity to develop his/her potential.

Entrepreneurship outside Europe: **43 talented young Belgians** who have conducted a one-year mission on behalf of Belgian companies are honoured by the Prince Albert Fund.

# AFTER THE FLOODS: SOLIDARITY WITHOUT FRONTIERS

Following the disastrous floods in the summer of 2021, the King Baudouin Foundation mobilises its philanthropic tools, expertise and networks to strengthen solidarity shown by citizens, companies and organisations.

The **EU Staff Fund** receives donations from EU civil servants to help the victims of floods in Belgium, the Netherlands and Germany.

Other Funds managed by the Foundation, such as the Solvay Solidarity Fund, take action as well. This wave of solidarity results in additional funding for fire services, schools, museums and associations in Belgium, Europe and throughout the world.



# UNLOCK YOUR ENERGY! MOBILISATION AGAINST COVID-19


Faced with the ever-present consequences of the Covid-19 pandemic, which have affected the whole of society, we continue to mobilise efforts to meet the needs on the sites.

Launched in spring 2021, the call for projects 'Unlock your energy!' aimed to answer the needs of young people, whose well-being was severely impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic.

Support totalling 800,000 euros is going to 102 sports, cultural, social, artistic and other projects run by and for young people to help to restore their morale.
