Selection criteria

In order to be **eligible** the project must correspond to the object of the call as it is described on this site and it must not be of a commercial nature. All projects must be located in a country where Solvay is active (<u>https://www.solvay.com/en/solvay-around-the-world</u>).

During its **selection** process, the jury will pay attention to the following criteria:

- the potential impact and innovative character of the project
- the project must be clear, concrete and realistic
 - it must be possible to implement it with the stated funding and within the stated timetable
 - the summary of the project must be as accurate as possible and it has to be stated to what expenses the Fund's grant is going to be allocated.
- the funding provided by the Fund
 - can be complementary but should not take the place of public funding
 - covers the expenses necessary to carry out the project, not the sponsoring expenses related to the marketing or advertising, nor logistical costs.
 - Must be critical to the success of the project. The jury will select projects where the support provided by the Fund makes a real difference to the beneficiary organization.

Please take these aspects into account in your application form since it is the only tool available to the jury for the evaluation.
